

CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR DINING TABLES



RECLAIMED RUSSIAN OAK TABLES

- Use coasters or placemats to help prevent marks or stains.
- Do not place hot items directly on the tabletop.
- Wipe the table clean with a soft, dry cloth after each use.
- Clear furniture wax can be applied to protect the finish from minor spills. Briwax, a high-quality finishing wax, is our furniture sealant of choice; apply as directed. Please note that slight variations in color and an incomplete seal may occur with any sealant; test on an inconspicuous area first.



SALVAGED WOOD TABLES

- Use coasters or placemats to help prevent marks and stains.
- Clear furniture wax can be applied to protect the finish from minor spills. Briwax, a high-quality finishing wax, is our furniture sealant of choice; apply as directed. Please note that slight variations in color and an incomplete seal may occur with any sealant; test on an inconspicuous area first.

NATURAL FINISH:

- Wipe wood with a slightly damp cloth; note that a small amount of the finish may transfer to the cloth.
- Mop up spills with a dry cloth.
- Stains may be removed by lightly sanding with 320-grit sandpaper.

BROWN, BLACK OR GREY FINISH:

- Wipe wood with a soft, dry cloth; mop up spills with a wet cloth.

SIDEBOARDS WITH GLASS DOORS:

- Wipe glass using a damp cloth with mild soap and water, followed by a dry cloth.



FINE VENEER TABLETOPS

- Use coasters or placemats to help prevent marks or stains.
- Do not place hot items directly on the tabletop.
- Wipe the table clean with a soft, dry cloth after each use.



UNSEALED RECLAIMED WOOD TABLES

- Use coasters or placemats to help prevent marks or stains.
- Do not place hot items directly on the tabletop.
- Wipe up spills quickly with a clean cloth.
